- Competition is open only to VA AIBD members.
- Each member is only allowed three (3) entries.
- All entries must be post marked by September 10, 2010. Entries after that date will not be accepted.
- *Custom:*
 - Entrants must submit a maximum of ten 8"x10" color photos of finished product (constructed dwelling).
 - Atleast three of the photos must be a combination of exterior views of the front, side and rear.
 - Interior photos should showcase prominent design features.
 - Rooms may be furnished and unfurnished.
 - An 8.5"x11 Study Plan must be submitted for each floor level.
 - An 8.5"x11 Front Rendering may be submitted as well.
 - All photos, study plans and renderings must be inserted in clear sleeves and submitted in a 1" three ring white binder.
 - Binders and all the contents within must not be identified by name or business.
 - Please provide a CD containing all submitted information in JPEG.
- *Renovation/Addition:*
 - Entrants must submit a maximum of ten 8"x10" color photos of finished product (constructed dwelling).
 - Atleast three of the photos must be a combination of exterior views of the front, side and /or rear if applicable.
 - Interior photos should showcase prominent design features.
 - Photos may be labeled "*before*" and "*after*".
 - Rooms may be furnished and unfurnished.

- An 8.5"x11 Study Plan must be submitted for each floor level (before and after).
- An 8.5"x11 finished rendering may be submitted as well.
- All photos, study plans and renderings must be inserted in clear sleeves and submitted in a 1" three ring white binder.
- Binders and all the contents within must not be identified by name or business.
- Please provide a CD containing all submitted information in JPEG.
- *Working Drawings:*
 - Submit a complete set of working drawings on bond paper.
 - Drawing sheet size may be determined by the designer.
 - All sets must be bound together on one edge.
 - Name, company identification, seal, model names and numbers must be deleted or completely blocked out on all sheets and border edge.
 - Plan sets must be organized. Content should **atleast** have basic typical information consisting of a cover sheet, foundation plan & details, floor plans, elevations, wall sections, door & window schedules, and an electrical layout (if not on floor plan). Other plan information may be submitted.
 - Please provide a CD containing all submitted information in JPEG.
